- 5. All acts **MUST** provide their own props, costumes and music on a CD or memory stick and must arrive dressed and ready to perform on the night.
- 6. Successful applicants will be notified of their audition time.
- The final successful acts taking part in the show will be notified by Wednesday 12th
 February 2025 so you can perfect your act in the half term.
