We will be learning:

Our project concepts this term are: power, change and sustainability



English Learning

In English, we will be completing our studies of Sophie Anderson's *The House with Chicken Legs*. We will be practising our prose and poetry writing, as well as learning performance skills. We will be learning:


- About the themes and motifs in the book
- About poetic devices including meter and rhyme
- About characterisation and narrative
- To write our own poetic monologues and dialogues
- To perform slam-style poetry in front of another class
- Advanced grammar including colons, semi-colons and parethesis

Mathematical Learning

This half term we are looking at:

- Working with decimals and how to add and subtract them
- Consolidating understanding of the four formal operations
- Understanding negative numbers
- Converting units of measure
- Working out the volumes of shapes and related problems





French Learning

This half term we will be deepening our understanding of the French language with Mrs Gibbs.

PSHE Learning

We will be learning about human rights and how we can be a good citizen



Scientific Learning

This half term will be completing *Life Cycles and Habitats* and *Forces*. We will learn:


- The forces at work on our planet and in the universe
